Winter in North Carolina can be a varied and splendid thing. A few weeks ago, we were slammed in the Research Triangle Park area with six inches of paralyzing white powdery stuff. Thankfully, since then, the temps have soared into the 70's and we had plenty of rain to wash the brine away. So, for our trip to visit the Bimmer Performance Center on February 20th, the roads were clear, the ambient temperature was good, and the modest showers something of a relief. Good times ahead.



For our adventure this month, the dining club with a driving problem headed off to visit the new home of our old friends at the BPC. Dan Connor and his team have been helping us keep the Roundels spinning for 15+ years now and many of us were well acquainted with the old shop that was hiding in the back of an industrial park, across the street from a quarry. You really needed to be committed to finding the shop. And, as many of us learned, it was well worth the trip. Keeping my dad's 1984 E30 or our 2023 X3M40 serviced (between trips to the dealer) were just some of the things that were part of visiting the old digs.

More than half a decade ago, Dan began a journey to build a new and purpose-built shop to accommodate the growing business. Of course, a pandemic, a shortage of building materials, and a

variety of other speed bumps presented themselves along the way. Persistence was never a problem, however, and the new shop opened in September of 2025. And this is like nothing many of us have ever seen before. The pictures tell a terrific story about the quality of the facilities and the sense of calm and comfort that accompany arrival in the drive through breezeway. Stand in front of the building and you realize that BMW's famous Hofmeister Kink has been recreated in the windows.



For us, this turned into a huge event! We lost track of the actual number of people who came through and visited with Dan and the team, but we estimate that it was around 75. Folks with M-cars, people with 2002's, a surprising number of Clown Shoes, and a wild array of X-vehicles were part of a stuffed parking lot. Neither the boxes of donuts or Joe survived very long, but no one cared. Hearing Dan tell the story of how the shop came to be, why the lifts in the back are wider than all the rest, what the balcony doors are for ... it was all a blast. We also had the chance to share a BMW CCA award with him to celebrate all the terrific support he has provided the club over the years. Wunderbar!



Eventually, this being a car club, we actually did need to drive SOMEWHERE. So, we saddled up the Bimmers and headed for the lovely small town of Franklinton. There we found a new sports pub called Bleachers. Equipped with what appears to be the largest TV on the planet, this is an ideal place to kick tires, tell lies, eat Bratwurst, and watch the Olympics out of the corner of one's eye.

We told them to expect around 20 people. When we showed up with 40, they said "no problem". Even though our skills for estimation are decidedly questionable, the service and food quality were not. Our waitress' name was Grace, and she had plenty of that. We will be heading back there for sure.
